Expressions of Interest 2019-20

The Injury Prevention and Management Foundation (Foundation) was established by the Motor Accidents Insurance Board (MAIB) to fund research, education and service development projects designed to address one or more of the following priority areas:

- Promotion and advancement of road safety;
- Reduction in the frequency and severity of injuries resulting from motor accidents;
- Improved access to quality medical, rehabilitation and long-term care services for those injured in motor accidents; and
- Development of new techniques and approaches to improve the quality management of injuries and long term outcomes for those injured in motor accidents.

The Foundation is now inviting expressions of interest from individuals, groups and organisations to undertake relevant projects during the 2019-20 funding period. Applications must clearly articulate the link of the projects outcomes to at least one of the priority areas of the Foundation.

Project durations should be:

- No longer than 12 months (not requiring recurrent funding – preferred option); or
- Up to three (3) years (subject to annual reviews by the Foundation).

Standard Conditions apply to all organisational, group or individual projects approved for funding by the Foundation.
